This is the Information of CORPORAL JESSICA OLIVIA LANGVIN, a member of THE ROYAL CANADIAN MOUNTED POLICE, of Saint John, New Brunswick.

The informant says that she has reasonable and probable grounds to believe and does believe that:

- Count 1: MARCUS DUPRES, on or about the 17th day of April, in the year 20--, at the City of Saint John, in the Province of New Brunswick, did conspire together with DEVON MALLICK and diverse persons unknown, to commit an indictable offence, to wit: having in his possession a narcotic, to wit MDMA (ecstasy), for the purpose of trafficking, contrary to section 5(2) of the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act* and sections 4(3), 354(1), and 355(2) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.
- Count 2: MARCUS DUPRES, on or about the 17th day of April, in the year 20--, at the City of Saint John, in the Province of New Brunswick, did have in his possession a narcotic, to wit MDMA (ecstasy), for the purpose of trafficking, contrary to section 5(2) of the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act*.
